## Updates to Minimum Supported Application Operating Systems

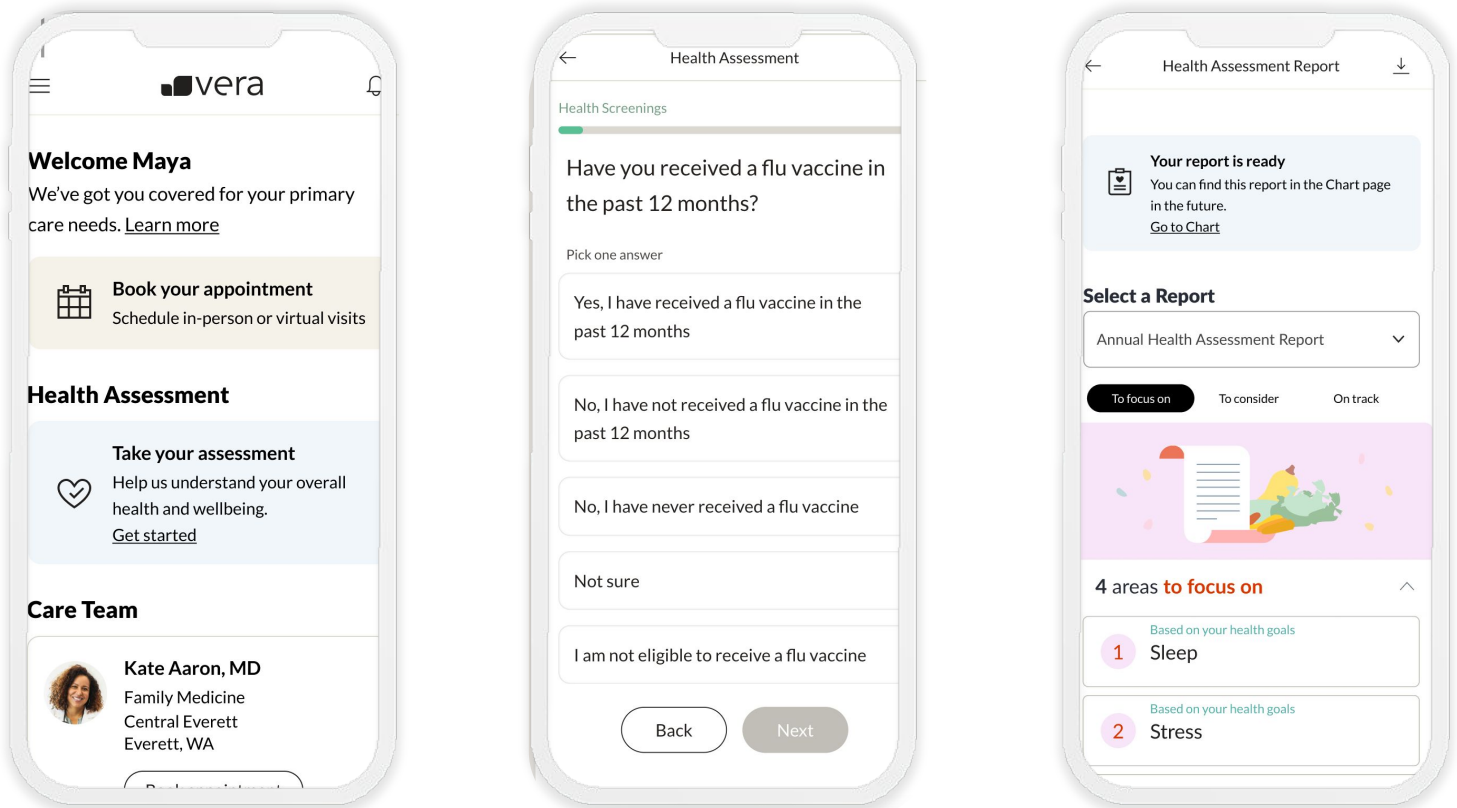
We are excited to announce an update to the minimum supported OS version for our product. To ensure a smoother, more reliable user experience, we are increasing the minimum operating system version required to run our application. **The new minimum supported versions will be iOS 16 and Android 10.**

**Why the Change?** As technology evolves, we continuously strive to provide you with the best performance, security, and features. The updated minimum OS version will enable us to leverage newer technologies, enhance security protocols, and offer an overall better user experience. In reviewing platform utilization, less than 1% of members are on an older OS system.

### What does this mean?

1. All users on supported versions (iOS 16/Android 10 or later) will continue to have a seamless experience with all updates and new features
2. **Existing users** with older device versions will still be able to use the app, but they won't receive new feature updates or be able to download the latest version
3. **New users** with older devices will not be able to download the app from the app store

## My Vera: Digital Health Assessment



Patients using My Vera are now able to complete the health risk assessment within their digital platform. They can access the health assessment directly on the homepage post-login. The health assessment provides member-level insights into clinical priorities, goals, and SDoH factors that could be barriers to care. Based on member response, our clinical services team can outreach for care management, coaching, and gaps in care closure. Members can review their recommended next steps post-health assessment completion and reference them at any point by navigating to the Charts tab.
